Objective

- Write a scientific paper of **12 pages**
 - ▶ meaning: maybe 11,5
 - ▶ but NOT 20 pages!
- At the end of this course you will present a term paper, which summarizes your **own** personal research

Term Paper Process

Process for the development of the term paper

- Read and analyse the topic catalogue in the syllabus document:

- Register for a topic by February 2, 2025:

first come - first served
- Work on the topic and compose findings
 - ▶ refer to the state of the art
 - ▶ **don't duplicate** the content from the lecture
 - ▶ Term paper should be written in English
- **Interact** with your term paper advisor and arrange bilateral report sessions
- Improve the term paper based on the **reviews**
